SUBJECT: 4TH OF JULY FIREWORKS EVENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

One of the annual fund raising events that the Boosters participate in is to help the City of Poway host the 4th of July Fireworks Show held at the Poway High School Stadium. The city provides ½ of the admissions received to the Boosters in return for our volunteer support of the event. Throughout the evening we will oversee admissions into the stadium, concession sales and security.

There will be a few changes this year to the program. Typically, there is a live band performance in the afternoon prior to the show, and numerous concession vendors are at the event providing food and drink. This year, there will be no live music, and no outside concessions. With these changes, the event will be shortened, beginning at 7:00 instead of 5:00, and the Boosters will have the opportunity to coordinate the sale of prepackaged food and drink. That means that we should be able to make more money from the event, but we will need more volunteer support.

We worked security at the event last year, and it was very uneventful (no pun intended). We will need approximately 8 groups of 2 (to work the perimeter security), 8 volunteers to work ticket sales at the 2 entrances, and 6 volunteers to help in the concession sales. This would be candy, chips and drinks only. Additionally, we will need to ask for a few volunteers to stay at the end of the show to help to a quick clean up of the field and track area. We would like for some of the students to help with concessions. The time frame is from 6:45 p.m. to approximately 10:00 p.m.

Please let us know if you are available to take on a volunteer role. You get free admission to a great show, and you will help the Boosters support the Music Program at Poway High.
