POLICY AGREEMENT FORM

OUR SIGNATURES BELOW INDICATE THAT WE:

1. Have completely read a copy of the 2010-2011 Poway High School Instrumental Music Program Student Handbook.
2. Will abide by all policies contained in the Handbook under the following outlined headings:

3. Understand the policy that any student wishing to participate in the PHS Instrumental Music Program must have paid all outstanding moneys owed to the Music Program on or before the date due. This includes:
 - a) Outstanding fees from prior years.
 - b) Basic Music Program Fees (see Form F for fee breakdown):
 - 1) **Orchestra** \$200
 - 2) **Non-Marching** \$200
 - 3) **Marching** \$500
 - 4) **Color Guard** \$600
 - 5) **Drum Line / Front Ensemble** \$50
 - c) Payment of at least 50% of your total fee is due at your assigned UNIFORM FITTING or Registration Day. ALL BALANCES ARE DUE WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2010.
 - d) Supplemental clothing items must be paid in full at the UNIFORM FITTING
 - e) **Winter Guard** - Fee of \$500 due in January 2011
 - f) **Winter Percussion** - Fee of \$225 due in January 2011
 - g) A discount of \$20 for each subsequent student beyond the oldest enrolled in the program in a family will be granted
