

**General Booster Board Meeting
Poway High Music Boosters
December 14, 2010**

General Boosters Meeting called to order at 7:38pm.

President's Report (Leon Stone):

- Leon and Richard Stegman went to PUSD meeting with superintendent regarding fees on November 16, 2010.
- All principals from the high schools were there, as well as the band boosters' presidents and various sports boosters.
- Superintendent used band stuff in his examples.
- We can use the term "fees" for personal items such as shoes, gloves, and bus transportation.
- ACLU wants to work with schools but force Sacramento at the same time to fund our education.

Treasurer's Report (Greg Yule):

- Numbers are a little clearer this month. \$15,000 more income projected for a total of \$113,000 income, expenses of \$62,000 more to equal \$131,000 in expenses for an overall projected deficit of \$18,000.
- These figures do not take into account the Spring fundraiser, Poway's Got Talent.

Holiday Music Fundraiser (Richard Stegman):

- Fundraising goal is \$5000.
- We have a lot of students signed up.
- New coffee locations not going to very well. Candy Cane Lane is all booked.
- There are 84 shifts and we are about half way covered.
- More parents are needed to work the various shifts.
- Tarps will be put up if it is raining.
- In-n-Out and Islands to provide luncheons for students who play 3 or more shifts.

Concert Concessions (Donna Payton):

- She needs cookies, hot cocoa packets and hot cider packets. Has asked for donations and has received some responses.
- Can put cookies into \$1 size baggies.

Spring Fundraiser – Poway's Got Talent (Dave Brown):

- Poway's Got Talent (PGT) update: 6 non-band groups (cheer, AVID, speech & debate, choir, peer counseling and dance team) and 1 band group (Emily Cade

group) are already scheduled to perform. Total groups wanted are 12: 9 non-band groups and 3 band groups.

- Mr. Cook needs to approve the music groups.
- Need a parent to go out and get prizes for the opportunity drawing.
- Date is set for Friday, March 4, 2011 at the PAC.
- There will be a meal before the performance for 200 people.

Ways and Means Report (Kari Lingo):

- Recycling drive in January 2011 – student leadership is working on it. Quality Recycling. Mention Poway High Music Boosters when dropping off items. Drop receipt in green basket, include name and class. Highest recycling class period will receive a build your own ice cream sundae. Color guard is included. Look for advertisement in the Chieftain.
